What happens when student athletes don't have to worry about uniform or travel costs accrued to compete in the **sport they love?** The sport that could enable them to move on to four-year colleges and universities? They become national champions.

In the last eight years, the CCC Wrestling program has raised approximately \$215,000 at their annual Crab Feed event. In 2019, \$45,000 supported the team as they earned their third national championship and Coach Josh Rhoden was awarded the NICAA National coach of the vear. Coach Rhoden started this event as a way to supplement travel costs the team was accumulating throughout the season, and it has been a highlight for alumni, donors and parents to attend. As this event continues, it will surely bring our wrestlers into a newdecade of dominance. Go Cougars!

The 2019 Corporate Challenge Golf Tournament was a highlight event to raise money for the Student Opportunity Fund.

Twenty teams joined together to spend a day on the greens, playing for Cougars. I have a passion for geology and biology and I wanted to share that passion with **CCC students.** I was a geology professor at CCC from 1973 to 2003 and developed a number of classes, including the Malheur Field Trip and Natural History of Death Valley. I also donated some of my collections including fossils, minerals, and birds to display in the DeJardin science building on the Oregon City campus.

I shared my passion with students for over three decades, and I wanted to continue even after I retired. Just because I'm not there to provide field trips, doesn't mean they have to stop! I know firsthand the struggles many students face, but those struggles shouldn't stop them from realizing their dreams. So, I started the John Snively Endowment to provide scholarships for the science field trip programs offered at CCC. This endowment enables me to make a difference in students' lives for many decades to come, and that's the best legacy I could ask for."



With a long-standing partnership of 19 years, Clackamas Community **College and Portland General Electric** (PGE) continue to offer our community a pathway to career advancement and continuing education in the utility **industry.** The CCC Wilsonville campus is the center of our partnership. The Utility Training Alliance Endowment, a \$1 million endowment, originally established by PGE and PacifiCorp, provides a scholarship to existing apprenticeship students in the electrical trades and enables high school students to experience the many career facets throughout the utility industry. We are incredibly proud of the unique learning center for our community that the CCC-Wilsonville campus and our PGE partnership have created.

Students, services and *Slices*

CCC is changing the way we serve students and greet visitors to our Oregon City campus. Recently, we broke ground on our new Welcome **Center.** This building will serve as the "front door" to the college, and will offer the following services: admissions, advising, counseling, education partnerships, financial aid, registration, testing and placement services and a welcome desk. In addition, the attached and remodeled Bill Brod Community Center will house the Disability Resource Center, Veterans Center, Associated Student Government and the Cougar Café. We are intentionally creating a space where students can have most of their questions answered in one sitting rather than moving to different offices or between buildings. This is the last of the bond projects from the bond passed in 2014, and the new building will feature a variety of services including:

DRC: The Disability Resource Center provides services that are designed to



support student success by creating a welcoming, inclusive and accessible environment.

Counseling: Free counseling services are offered to our students. They help students who are struggling and in need of therapy, advice or resources.

Veterans Center: CCC is proud to serve our veterans and military family members. Clackamas Community College is honored to be ranked the #6 "Best for Vets" two-year school in the nation by Military Times. The Veterans Center helps with VA educational benefit enrollment, information about all types for veterans benefits, education and career information, financial support for veterans and their dependents through scholarships and grants, referrals to additional resources and much more.

Associated Student Government:

Associated Student Government (ASG) has a passion for serving others. The ASG serves students in many ways, including offering grants, locker rentals, textbook library and a food and/or hygiene item pantry.





In the fall of 2019, we hosted a community giving day with MOD Pizza in **Oregon City.** MOD Pizza generously donated 100% of their proceeds that day to the

CCC Foundation, totaling \$4,941.56. Funds raised will help provide aid to students for textbooks, transportation and child care through ASG grants. Community members stepped up to


