PERSEVERANCE during the pandemic

In March, the COVID-19 pandemic caused Clackamas Community College and the CCC Foundation to quickly pivot all operations to safely serve and educate students. Many of our students suddenly faced incredible hardships, but you stepped up. You stood in the gap during an unprecedented challenging time, and you kept students moving forward.

The leadership of the Foundation and donors like you made \$200,000 available to our Covid-19 Student Relief Fund. These funds helped hundreds of students by providing resources to overcome educational barriers caused by remote learning, such as laptops and

technological support as well as textbooks and materials. In addition, emergency grants of up to \$500 per applicant, for needs such as groceries or rent, were awarded to students who faced a financial hardship due to COVID-19. Your generosity made it possible for these students to continue their education uninterrupted despite these sudden challenges presented by the pandemic.

The Covid-19 pandemic also inspired us to acknowledge the courage of others during the year. President Cook did one of the most unique things to honor community members: He ran marathon. "It was a marathon of one," he teased, "I took first place and set a course record."

President Cook is a regular marathon runner, having completed more than 30 marathons to date, and this one was special to him. Thirteen laps around the campus provided him a way to honor first responders and those impacted by the pandemic, one lap at a time. The last lap was the most meaningful as it honored the 2020 graduating class. Way to go President Cook, we appreciate you, too!

HONORING NURSES

Last spring we came to appreciate our healthcare workers, more than ever before, for the heroes they are. This includes the amazing students and instructors of CCC's nursing program.

Sadly, due to COVID-19 restrictions, many families were unable to mourn loved ones who passed away in 2020. Last year, the CCC community lost two incredible nurses – alum Dione Hubred '02, and retired faculty, Geraldine "Gerry" Harrington. We want to take this opportunity to honor them.

Nurse Dione Hubred 1970-2020

After graduating high school, Dione served for four years as a Navy field medic. Shortly after becoming a mom to Lars Hubred in 1994, she started working toward her nursing degree at Clackamas Community College. She was an incredibly hard worker, balancing raising Lars as a single mom and working nights as a CNA while finishing her degree. Dione graduated from CCC in 2002 and began working at Portland Providence, where she spent her entire nursing career. Dione continued to work nights as a charge nurse, while building a tight-

Nurse Geraldine "Gerry" Harrington 1924-2020

In 1968, Gerry was the second faculty member hired for a new nursing program being established at Clackamas Community College. As one of the founding instructors, Gerry taught from her experience as a nursing graduate during World War II and her service all throughout the state. She taught at CCC from 1968 until her retirement in 1987. To honor her contribution to student success, her colleagues started an endowment in her name when she retired. The Geraldine Harrington Endowment provides scholarships to nursing students who excel in the clinical setting and who possess a gift for delivering quality care.

For over 20 years, Les de Asis, founder of Benchmade Knife Company, partnered with Clackamas Community College, educating students and industry leaders with his contagious and entrepreneurial presence. We were deeply saddened by his passing in 2020.

To honor his profound impact in our community, the new makerspace in the college's Holden Industrial Technology Center on the Oregon City campus is now named in memory of Les. His tenacious and innovative spirit embodies this

center for invention, designed for use by community members, students throughout multiple programs, and employers.

The naming of the makerspace after Les is fitting as he started his business by designing and building knives in his garage. Benchmade knives are now coveted around the world. The makerspace will provide opportunities for similar entrepreneurs with exploration, skill-building and business development.

An industrial workshop like this does not exist anywhere else in Clackamas county.

To ensure the makerspace is

accessible and affordable to all people in the community, Benchmade, the de Asis family, and Les' colleagues and friends nationwide have donated in support of the Les de Asis Makerspace. To date, this project has generated over \$100,000 in donations to get this program started, funding operational and program needs.

CCC is treating the makerspace like a start-up, with the assumption that sustainability can be achieved as news of its presence in the community generates greater demand. Based on this growing demand, the makerspace will create financial resources through college support, donations, and user fees.

The first few weeks of September 2020 devastated our community. Shocking wildfires ripped through precious Oregon lands and towns. Like many residents throughout the county, you may have had to evacuate and find shelter elsewhere. Tragically, some of you may have even lost your homes and businesses.

It was an incredible feat for CCC to respond to. At first, our Oregon City campus became a designated Red Cross shelter for evacuated residents and their animals. Then, up to 1,000 first responders from every part of the state were stationed at a fire camp on campus as they worked against the Riverside fire.

It became quickly apparent that these heroes would need round-the-clock resources through the college like food, showers, and shelter to sustain them.

In less than 12 waking hours, neighbors, evacuees, and distant friends donated to CCC's support of first responders. Just over \$25,000 supplied them with endless coffee refills, warm meals from CCC's cafe, and lunches to take with them during their 12hour shifts.

It was encouraging for the next generation of first responders, too. Additional funds raised to support the fire camp would later provide scholarships for essential protective gear for enrolled students seeking to complete their field training in CCC's wildland firefighting programs. CCC's fire science program provides education and training that can lead to seasonal or permanent employment with state, federal and private contract firefighting or within the timber industry.

Your bond dollars ATWORK

In November 2014, voters in the Clackamas Community College district approved a \$90-million bond measure that was used to update and expand college classrooms and labs and modernize equipment to meet industry standards. Passage of the bond also resulted in CCC receiving \$32 million in state matching funds, which were used to support Harmony West, the Holden Industrial Technology Center, the DeJardin/Pauling Science Complex, and the Welcome Center.

As the last bond project broke ground in March 2020, we wanted to give you a look back and celebrate all that

was accomplished with the tremendous support of our community. Here are some of the highlights. >>>>

BOND PROJECT ZONE

Clackamas

HARMONY WEST



Completed in the fall of 2017, Harmony West allowed CCC to continue to grow its health science, workforce development and general education offerings on the Harmony Community Campus. Students can now start and complete a number of academic career pathways at this location. Harmony West replaced the 61-year-old former OIT/Dale Ickes Junior High building.

HOLDEN INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY CENTER



Completed in 2018, the Holden ITC increases teaching, training, and partner space, as well as creating flexibility to meet the changing training needs of regional partnership programs. The Renewable Energy Technology Lab opens to an exterior covered workspace and the Flex Lab contains a range of robotics and trainers.

DEJARDIN EXPANSION



The 35-year-old science complex on the Oregon City campus was outdated and contributed to class overcrowding and long wait lists, which both contributed to increased student time to completion and lower retention. This project doubled the college's chemistry lab capacity and additional biology classes can be offered due to efficient prep space. This project was completed in 2019.

AUTOMOTIVE REMODEL



In January 2020, Clackamas Community College opened its garage bay doors to its newly remodeled and expanded Automotive Department. The remodel and expansion provides students and instructors the space they need for a productive learning environment. Students learn hands-on, with state-of-the-art equipment, in a space that mimics real shops.









OPENING OCTOBER 2021! WACHENO WELCOME CENTER

In the spring of 2020, we began construction on the renovation of the Community Center and building the Wacheno Welcome Center, allowing the college to colocate critical support services such as veterans services, disabilities resources, and career coaching, in one convenient location, ensuring students stay in school and on track with their career and academic pathways.

CCC Foundation is offering a limited number of naming opportunities for the Wacheno Welcome Center. These opportunities provide recognition to a group of dedicated citizens and organizations who support community college education.
